### **2022– 2023 Required Documents**

- ⇒ 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Form (apply at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)). Do not leave any items blank – include an answer to every question. (Note: You must have the (completed/filed) 2020 federal tax returns for you and spouse, if applicable in order to complete this form accurately).
- ⇒ Title IV Authorization Form (MSM Website)

### **Deadline -June 15, 2022**

**\*\*Missing Data on the 22-23 FAFSA Form will result in a delay in processing your file. No missing or blank financial data.**

**Please do not submit a 2020 Federal tax return unless requested.**

**\*\*ALL STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE STUDENT SECTIONS (1-57) OF THE FAFSA FORM (IN ITS ENTIRETY) .**

- ◆ Students should expect to receive a tentative award letter mid July, if your file is complete.
- ◆ Additional documents (including tax documents) may be requested to establish Title IV eligibility.
