

## **PI Withdrawal Process**

This process outlines the steps a Principal Investigator (PI) must take to formally withdraw from a submitted **electronic Intent to Submit** (e-ITS) form. This ensures proper documentation and communication with all relevant stakeholders.

- 1. The PI determines they will no longer pursue the proposal submission.
- 2. The PI informs the GMO Pre-Award Research Administrator as soon as possible.
- 3. The PI must complete the PI Withdrawal Form (see below). All required fields must be filled out to ensure clarity on the reason for withdrawal.
- 4. The unit chair or approving authority reviews and acknowledges the withdrawal.
- 5. The completed form must be submitted to the GMO Pre-Award Research Administrator.
